What’s required from you?

1. Any text provided (in full) and any photographs (**maximum of 2**) that you want included. Please ensure that the text provided is **750 Words (or close)** in total and is in 'Word' or 'Notepad' format and emailed to the address given above.
2. An author contact name with email and/or telephone number. (we normally make contact, if required, via email as this is easier on our limited resources).
3. Supply any documents ('Word' or 'pdf' files) that you want to be available as downloads to visitors of the website. (**maximum of 4 items**)
4. Provide the URL's (or web address(es) of any external information or websites on the Internet you want to link from the article. (**maximum of 10 links per profile**).
